Dock Approval Committee

During the summer of 2014, a joint committee was formed between the TEA, TLPOA, and Vreeland properties to grant dock approvals for Lake Truesdale. In order to have a dock approved by the Truesdale Lake Dock Committee (TLDC) the dock must meet minimum standards outlined

on the lake website here:

The TLDC gives approvals or denials and then passes its decisions on to the town wetland commissioner and building department.

Without the **TLDC** approval, a homeowner will not get approval from the Town of Lewisboro to build or repair their dock.

The guidelines are - for the most part - common sense. There is a requirement to show proof of septic pumping in the past 18 months before any approval will be granted.
