What's Going On Lake Drawdown Project - Update

The Pond and Lake Connection (the company that has managed Truesdale Lake weed and algae control for the past two years) attempted to draw down Truesdale Lake at the end of 2018 but they ran into technical, material, and weather difficulties that ultimately doomed the project for this winter.

The unusually wet summer and fall pushed the installation back several weeks from the original plan of mid-October. Once the pipes were in, we received several very significant rainfalls that ended up filling the lake up faster than the pipes were able to drain it. The storms also disrupted the siphon pipes and interrupted the drawdown on several occasions.

This year was a learning experience for us and Pond & Lake Connection and we will be doing an analysis of what went wrong and how to correct and account for it if and when we attempt a drawdown in the future.

We will provide updates about any Truesdale Lake Drawdown plans as there is information to report. Information will be communicated via Next Door, Truesdale (website to the right \rightarrow in newsletter) the Truesdale Lake e-list and posting to truesdalelake.com/drawdown.

Meeting dates for 2019-20:
