#### **What's Going On**

#### Lake Drawdown Project

The Pond and Lake Connection (the company that has managed Truesdale Lake weed and algae control for the past three years) together with the Lake Management Committee spearheaded the Truesdale Lake drawdown for 2019-2020.

As detailed in our draw-down meeting in June, our neighbors Scot Evans, resident math whiz Harold Ossher, and our lake manager liaison Lara Gorton have done an unbelievable amount of work to evaluate the water flow and re-designed the siphon design to drawdown the water level this quickly. The initial drawdown went far quicker than anticipated, taking only 11 days to drain the top 3 feet from the lake. This was mainly due to a very dry August and September.

The unusual weather continued into October and November with rainfall above the normal amount causing the lake to refill several times in the fall. Each time, the siphons were restarted and the lake was drawn down again. The winter was not a cold one and we only had one snowstorm of any significance. It was an unusual year all around and it is documented in play-by-play detail on the lake website here:
