

Ownership of plots of land shown on this map carries with it the right to the owner and his family to the use of the following described plots and facilities of Truesdale Lake in common with other owners of plots of Truesdale Lake under such rules, regulations and restrictions as may, from time to time, be prescribed by the Truesdale Lake Corporation, its successors and assigns, in the common interest.

1. Right of access to Truesdale Lake by and over the roads and streets of the Truesdale Lake property as dedicated or set aside by the Truesdale Lake Corporation for the use of the colony at Truesdale Lake.

2. Right to the use of Truesdale Lake for the purposes of boating, bathing and fishing.


3. Right to the use of all that lot or parcel of land constituting a beach as the same now exists having one hundred feet of frontage upon the lake and adjoining the southerly side of lot #29 thereof as shown on certain map known as "Map of Section 11<sup>th</sup> of Truesdale Lake property, South Salem, Town of Lewisboro, Westchester County, New York," made by J. Albert Schaefer, dated April 15, 1926 and filed in the office of the Register of Westchester County as Map 11<sup>th</sup> 3015.

4. Right to the use of the northwesterly half of that lot or parcel of land being shown and designated as Lot 11<sup>th</sup> 19 on Map 11<sup>th</sup> 3015 above described.

5. Right to the use of all that lot or parcel of land being shown and designated as Lot 11<sup>th</sup> 19 on a certain map known as "Map of Section 4A of Truesdale Lake property, South Salem, Town of Lewisboro, Westchester County, New York," made by J. Albert Schaefer, dated Nov. 4, 1927 and filed in the office of the Register of Westchester County as Map 11<sup>th</sup> 3253.
